What to bring

- a dog on a regular buckle/quick-release collar and 4-6ft leash
- a variety of treats in a treat pouch
- a stuffed Kong/chew toy
- a poop bag (just in case!)

Class rules & management

- don't feed dog before class
- exercise & potty dogs before coming do not use neighbors' grass strips!
- cell phones off
- wear sensible/comfortable clothes & shoes
- door opened 5 minutes before start time
- dogs will be excited start working with them as soon as you get in
- late arrivals come on in, but wait in necessary for the right moment to find a seat
- children must remain seated unless working with a dog parents may need to handle leash for child at trainer's request.
- barking dog policy reactive dogs will be transferred to private lesson
- dogs are not to interact during class for everyone's comfort and safety
- please bring water if your dog needs it
